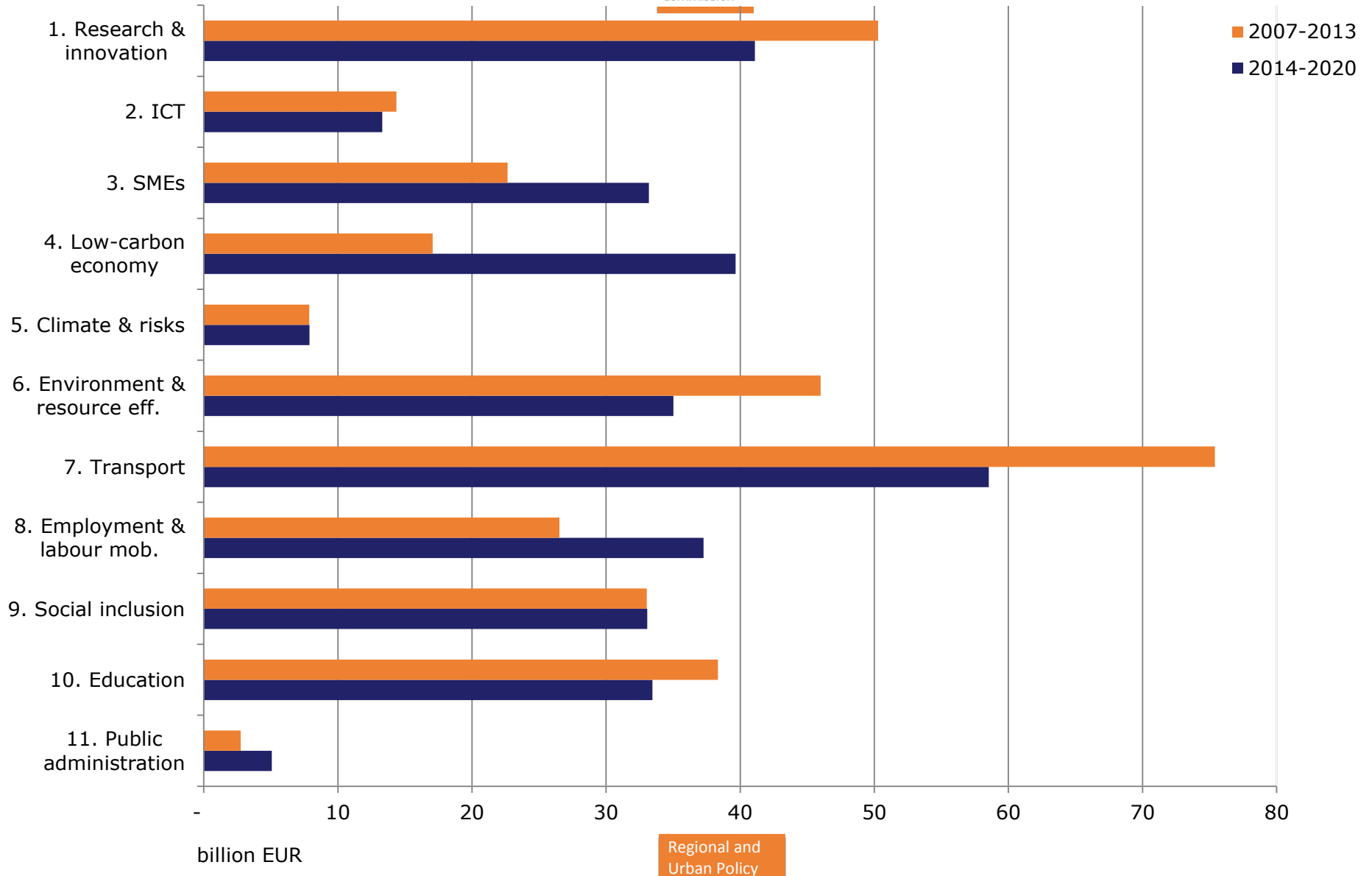

# 2014-2020 programming

- State of play November 2015:
  - Mainstream OPs: 204 out of 205 OPs adopted
  - ETC OPs: 69 out of 91 OPs adopted
  - All remaining OPs expected to be adopted in December 2015
- Report on outcome of negotiations (Art. 16 CPR) presented in December 2015
- Open data platform for 5 European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) launched in December 2015

## 25% for climate-related actions\*

- Estimated at 114 billion EUR for 5 ESI Funds
  - EAFRD: 56.0 billion EUR
  - ERDF: 37.7 billion EUR
  - CF: 17.6 billion EUR
  - ESF: 1.1 billion EUR
  - EMFF: 1.0 billion EUR
- Actions across all thematic objectives
- Both climate change mitigation and adaptation targeted

# What environmental measures will be supported?

(Mainly TO6)

- Significant improvements to **wastewater treatment and water supply**
- Improved **waste management** and additional recycling capacity in accordance with the waste hierarchy
- **Biodiversity** protection and conservation measures
- Investments in **natural and cultural heritage**, linked to tourism
- Other priorities: rehabilitation of industrial sites, air quality measures, integrated pollution prevention and control...

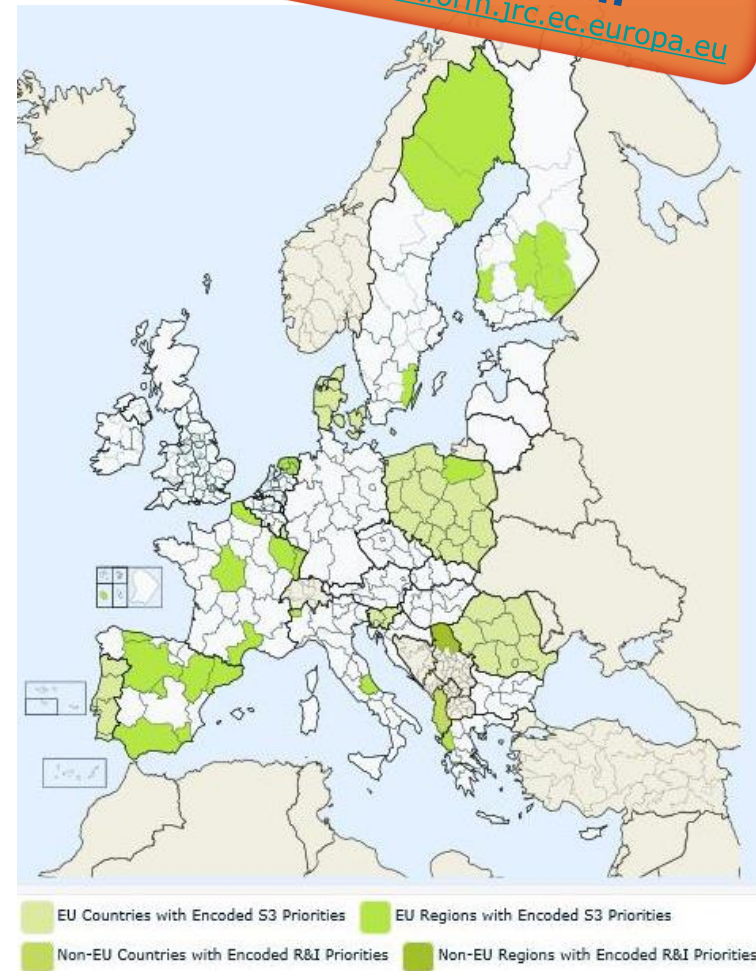
## 2014-2020: moving to implementation

- Cohesion Policy has a strong role in delivering Commission priorities on the ground
- Territorial dimension, including specific opportunities for cities and local authorities
  - Integrated actions for sustainable urban development (EUR 15bn): 19% for TO6
- Assistance and support tools
  - New guidance
  - fi-compass
  - EMA Network and Smart Specialisation Platform on Energy
  - PEER 2 PEER tool
  - ...

# Smart specialisation

- Linking environmental investments with (eco-)innovation
- Support from S3 Platform
- Thematic platforms:
  - Energy
  - Agro-food
  - Advanced manufacturing
  - ...
- Synergies with other EU funding
  - Stairway to Excellence
  - Seal of Excellence

## TAIEX-REGIO PEER 2 PEER



- Capacity-building tool to exchange know-how
  - Short-term expert missions, study visits or workshops
  - Launched in March 2015, runs as a pilot until mid-2016
  - 59 applications (from 14 MS) received, 13 implemented so far
  - Topics: financial instruments, public procurement, sustainable urban development, smart specialisation...
